

Greetings PAC families!!

Can you believe we're just about a week away from camptime?? We are getting so excited as we finalize all the final details. Please read EVERYTHING below. We need the dietary form below back ASAP from all campers. Others are just more details and reminders.

****NEW FORM NEEDED ASAP!!**** [Dietary Restrictions & Over the Counter Medications](#): We need one of these forms for EVERY CAMPER. Please complete this very quick simple form to let us know if your camper has any dietary restrictions, and to give consent to your camper receiving OTC medications from our camp nurse while at camp. [Without this form we cannot give your camper ibuprofen or any other over the counter meds.](#)

[Transportation Form](#): We need one of these from EVERY CAMPER!! Even if you are dropping your camper off by car we need this form. It also has your campers SHIRT SIZE on it - which we need ASAP to order show shirts for all campers. [Please submit this transportation form RIGHT NOW if you have not already.](#) **Check in/out times**: Check-IN is from 3-5 PM, and Check-OUT is from 10 AM - Noon. It is very important to not be early for check-in or late for check-out.

Vaccinations & Tests: As a reminder, please have your negative COVID test OR a copy (or original) of your camper's vaccination card at check-in. We are requiring one or the other from all at check-in. If you scanned/emailed your vaccination card with your med forms that's just fine and we have it. Please bring a copy of your vaccination card to camp if possible as well. Also remember, unvaccinated campers are required to have a parent/guardian within 2 hours of the campground at all times to assist with quarantining if necessary.

Emergency Cell Phone: 406-529-4743 Go ahead and save this number to your phones if it is not there already! Paisley will have the emergency cell at all times during camptime starting July 31. Please don't call/text before that time, as it is being used for MCT day camps.

What to PAC(k): PLEASE DON'T FORGET A WATER BOTTLE!!! This year due to health reasons we are not providing water bottles for campers. Please send a water bottle with your camper to make sure they stay hydrated! Also important items to make sure you have: bedding for twin & pillow, towels, masks, medications, comfy rehearsal shoes/sneakers, and clothes for the entire camp experience. No laundry facilities available. CAMPERS MAY NOT HAVE ANY FOOD ITEMS IN THEIR CABINS AS IT WILL ENCOURAGE NON-HUMAN CABINMATES!! Don't let your camper be the reason their cabin has pests!!!
